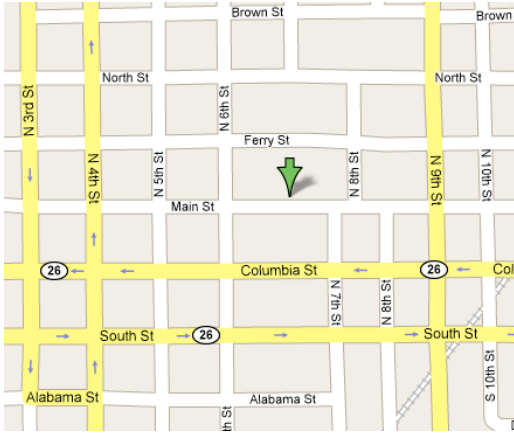

Support

Trans Lafayette now offers a **support group** that meets on the first and third Mondays of the month at 7pm. The support group is for transgender, transsexual, gender variant, genderqueer, and questioning individuals as well as significant others, friends, family, and allies, and is facilitated. The location, the Pride Lafayette Center, is private and safe. We discuss topics such as coming out, family, transitioning at work, navigating gender in society, intersections of identities, and medical issues.

Advocacy

Trans Lafayette has within its membership individuals dedicated to the cause of transgender, transsexual, gender variant, and genderqueer rights. These individuals work specifically on issues on the **Purdue campus** involving gender identity in campus policies, in the **cities and county** working to add gender identity to the human rights ordinances, and **advocating** for transgender, transsexual, gender variant, and genderqueer individuals. History

The political wing of Trans Lafayette is directly affiliated with the Indiana Transgender Rights Advocacy Alliance (INTRAA).
